# Wellness vs. problem visits for kids

# Helping families understand their options and cost

## Wellness visit scenario 1

- Exam based on child's age and growth.
- Guidance on nutrition, safety, and healthy habits.
- Monitoring milestones and development.
- Keeping immunizations and screenings up to date.

Often covered at little or no cost to families.

## **Problem visit** scenario 2

- Discuss any new health concern, illness or injury.
- Care for ongoing conditions such as asthma or ADHD.
- Adjust medications or treatment plans.

Insurance may require a copay or shared cost.

#### Wellness and problem visit scenario 3

- If time permits, we try our best to address problems and concerns at wellness visits.
- Federal law requires coding and billing for both parts separately.
- You may see charges for wellness and problem care.

Insurance may require a copay or shared cost (often less than paying for two separate visits).

#### Helpful questions for insurance

- Is my child's annual wellness visit covered?
- What immunizations, labs, or screenings are included?
- What costs will I pay if a **problem is discussed** during a wellness visit?
